- > Tag colour;
- > Type of fish; and
- > Length and weight (if possible).

If you catch a fish from the lower Athabasca region that looks unusual or unhealthy, please call RAMP at 780.742.5147 and provide the following information:

- > Where you caught the fish;
- > Type of fish; and
- > Type of abnormality.

Photos of the fish will also be useful.

If the fishing regulations allow, please keep the fish and submit for analysis (free of charge) by contacting the Canadian Cooperative Wildlife Health Centre (www.ccwhc.ca) at 1.888.966.5815 or RAMP at 780.742.5147 Please note that if a fish is kept for analysis, it is still considered part of your daily catch limit.
